

How to uninstall GearBox Connection Kit from a Windows Platform Machine:

1. Kill Gearbox if it is running by performing the following steps:
  - Type Ctrl-Alt-Del to bring up the task list.
  - Click on "GBTask" and End Task.
  - Type Ctrl-Alt-Del to bring up the task list.
  - Click on "Confsvr" and End Task.
2. Explore My Computer (right click the icon and click Explore), then find the Gearbox Connection Kit folder (C:\Program Files\Gearbox Connection Kit).
3. Delete the GearBox Connection Kit folder.
4. On the 'Start' menu select the 'Run' application.
  - Enter 'regedit' in the Open field of the 'Run' application window.
  - Click the 'OK' button of the 'Run' application window.
  - Notice that the 'Registry Editor' window is opened now.
5. In the 'Registry Editor' window:
  - Navigate to: HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\Software\Rockstar Software.
  - Select the 'Rockstar Software' folder.
  - With the 'Rockstar Software' folder selected, right click the folder and select the 'Delete' option from the popup menu list.
  - Notice that a 'Confirm Key Delete' dialog will appear asking "Are you sure you want to delete this key?"
  - Click the 'Yes' button of the 'Confirm Key Delete' dialog.
  - Close the 'Registry Editor' window.
6. Reboot! Your system is now guaranteed clean and ready to install GearBox again.
